Hi, I'm _____ and I will be administering the BrainScope test on you today that Dr. _____ ordered to help evaluate your head injury.

The BrainScope test is an FDA cleared device that collects brain EEG signals from the forehead, much like the EKG records the heart signal from the chest.

Before we start, I'm going to ask you some questions and enter the information into the device.

Now I'm going to use alcohol pads to clean your forehead and earlobes and apply a thin layer of gel to these areas before I place a plastic band with sensors that will stick to your forehead and earlobes. The gel will feel cool on your skin when I apply it and the sensors will come off easily when the test is done.

Ok—we're all set to begin. The test is going to take about 5 minutes during which I will periodically give you updates on the progress of the test.

Sit back in a relaxed position. Take a few deep breaths. Close your eyes, stay completely still, and relax your face, shoulders, neck, and jaw.

Great—all done; you can open your eyes now. It will be just a few minutes to allow the device to generate your results before I help you remove the sensors.

The doctor will be in shortly to review the results with you.
